This seminar will review Ohio's new Limited Liability Company Act that went into effect on February 11, 2022 and discuss its implications for clients starting new companies and those that have LLC's in place. The new law provides added flexibility and clarity regarding company governance while aligning Ohio's statute with the Model Act. The seminar will address the implications of the new law's complete abrogation of the prior LLC statute and the effects on existing Operating Agreements which now have no statutory underpinnings. Consideration will be given to whether Operating Agreements in place before the effective date of the new law should be amended or replaced in their entirety and the potential legal consequences of doing neither. An example of an Operating Agreement that conforms with the new law will be presented and discussed.
